Thank you for your inquiry of Burley Christian School. Following is some general information about B.C.S.

Burley Christian School has been serving the community since 1979. It was established by concerned parents for their child's complete education: to train children in the ways of the Lord rather than in conformity to the world. This spiritual training is provided in a solid academic framework which will prepare the student to maximize his God-given abilities.

We have two school campuses.

**Main Campus: BBC:**

Preschool, Kindergarten, 1st and 2nd grades use A BEKA materials. Preschool is Tuesday and Thursday, 8:30 A.M. - 12:00 P.M. Kindergarten is Monday through Friday, 8:30 A.M. - 12:00 P.M., 1st and 2nd grades are Monday through Friday, 8:30 A.M. - 3:10 P.M.

3rd through 6th grade levels use a combination of A BEKA, and A.C.E. materials. Classes are Monday through Friday, 8:30 A.M. - 3:10 P.M.

**Miracle Ranch Campus:**

7th through 12th grade levels mainly use A BEKA curriculum. Classes are Monday through Friday, 8:15 A.M. – 2:55 P.M

Open enrollment for the following school year begins March 1<sup>st</sup>.  
Early registration for returning families begins February 1<sup>st</sup>.

**RETURING FAMILIES:**

The tuition schedule is as follows for **returning families**, billed Sept. through June, a statement is sent monthly:

<b>Preschool</b>	<b>\$1440/per year (\$144.00 per child/per month)</b>
<b>Kindergarten</b>	<b>\$2940/per year (\$294.00 per child/per month)</b>
<b>1st - 6th</b>	<b>\$4980/per year (\$498.00 per child/per month)</b>
<b>7th - 12th</b>	<b>\$6200/per year (\$620.00 per child/per month)</b>

There is a price break for more than one child per family for grades K-12th.  
If three children in one family are enrolled, the fourth and following are tuition free.

**NEW FAMILIES:**

The tuition schedule is as follows for **new families**, billed Sept. through June, a statement is sent monthly:

<b>Preschool</b>	<b>\$1510/per year (\$151.00 per child/per month)</b>
<b>Kindergarten</b>	<b>\$3080/per year (\$308.00 per child/per month)</b>
<b>1st - 6th</b>	<b>\$5230/per year (\$523.00 per child/per month)</b>
<b>7th - 12th</b>	<b>\$6490/per year (\$649.00 per child/per month)</b>

There is a price break for more than one child per family for grades K-12th.  
If three children in one family are enrolled, the fourth and following are tuition free.

Other fees at the time of application are as follows:

**PEP (Parents as Educational Partners) Hour Fee (per family)**

<b>Kindergarten-12</b>	<b>\$240 (24 hours of service)</b>
<b>Kindergarten-12 Single parent</b>	<b>\$120 (12 hours of service)</b>

This fee may be paid or “worked” off by volunteering at the school.  
Prices stated above are for the current school year, updated 2023, and are subject to change.

### **Discounts Available**

- Families who are members of Burley Bible Church receive \$200 discount.
- Prepaid tuition by Sept. 31<sup>st</sup> will receive a 5% discount.
- Pastoral tuition discount of 50% for full time pastors.
- Military tuition discount of 5% available for active military families.
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### **ADMISSIONS POLICY**

The following criteria must be met before the child's admission into the school.

1. Parents of prospective students must sign the Parent Pledge of Support.
2. Students in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade and above must sign the Student Pledge of Conduct.
3. Records must be obtained from previous schooling.
4. At least one parent and students must be church attending, practicing Christians.
5. Students must want to attend Burley Christian School.
6. Older students are to be an example for younger students.
7. Students with handicaps (mental, emotional or physical) will be admitted only if, in the opinion of the administration, their needs can be met by the school.  
Burley Christian School is not equipped to deal with serious handicaps.
8. Students must be at least four years old by September 15 to be considered for admission to Preschool.
9. Admission, retention, and promotion in the Preschool and Kindergarten programs is at the discretion of the school staff, based on the child's ability and maturity in a classroom setting. See # 6 below.
10. All immunizations must be current in accordance with state standards.

### **ADMISSIONS PROCEDURES**

1. Submit a Family Application Form.
2. Request your Pastor to complete and send/fax the Family Reference Form.
3. The school office will arrange an interview with both parents and pupil. Pledges will be signed at this interview.
4. Submit Enrollment Application, Health Info, Immunization Record, Field Trip Permission Form accompanied by previous report card if available. Secondary student applicants must complete and return the Student Questionnaire, Pledge of Conduct, and Student Commitment.  
Request former school records to be transferred, unless homeschooled. Homeschool students 8 years and older include SAT or annual testing results along with academic records.
5. An academic test shall be given to determine placement of students in grades 3-12. Kindergarten applicants will be given a test to determine the child's readiness for school.
6. Parents will be notified of acceptance.
7. Submit registration fee, curriculum fee, and applicable financial paperwork.
8. Attend Parent Orientation, held the first Monday evening after school begins.
