7. Who is it that returns with Him to rule and reign on the earth? Verse 14
Revelation 19:7-8; Matthew 25:31; Jude 14-15; 2 Thessalonians 1:7,10

8. What weapon will Christ use to destroy His enemies? Verses 15a, 21; 2 Thessalonians 2:8

9. How is God's justice described by which Christ will rule the nations? Verse 15b

10. What is the significance of the name written on His robe and thigh? Verse 16

11. Contrast the two suppers in this chapter. Verses 9, 17-18, 21

12. Describe the final end of Antichrist and his false prophet? Verses 19-20
