Text: Acts 2:44-47; Hebrews 10:24-25

The New Testament term *fellowship* comes from the Greek work *koinonia,* meaning to share in common. Someone has quipped that *fellowship is two or more fellows on the same ship headed to the same destination and sharing similar interests and purposes in common.*
