Icebreaker: Have each person share a brief testimony of when they first heard the call of Jesus to follow Him.

2. When we introduce someone to Jesus, what are the most important truths they need to understand about Him and about themselves? John 1:29, 35-36

3. What might Andrew and John have learned about Jesus by spending the day and possibly the night with Him after John the Baptist introduced them to Jesus? John 1:37-39; Matthew 8:20; 1 Corinthians 11:1

4. Who did Andrew want to share his new found Savior and Messiah with, and how can we apply this in our own lives? John 1:40-42

5. What difference can following Jesus make in our lives as demonstrated in Jesus' promise to Peter? John 1:42

6. Who did Jesus call to follow Him on the next day after his encounter with Andrew and John? John 1:43-44

7. Who was Philip then excited to tell about his Savior and Messiah? John 1:45

8. Why was Nathanael cautious and skeptical about Jesus being the promised Messiah?
John 1:46a

9. What wise answer and invitation did Philip give to Nathanael? John 1:46b

10. What was Nathanael's response when he realized Jesus already knew all about him?
John 1:47-49

11. What did Jesus mean when he said Nathaniel would see the angels of God ascending and descending upon the Son of Man? John 1:50-51; Genesis 28:10-12

12. What call did Jesus make to Andrew, Peter, James and John in Mark 1:16-20?
Proverbs 11:30; Psalm 126:5-6
