4. What do John 1:1-3, Colossians 1:16, Hebrews 13:8, 1 John 1:1-3 & Revelation 1:8 teach us about Jesus Christ?

5. According to Colossians 1:17, what is the force that holds this universe together?

6. How long did it take God to create this present creation? Exodus 20:11

7. How can we be sure that each day does not represent eons of time as some have alleged from 2 Peter 3:8? What reoccurring phrase do we find in Genesis 1:5, 8, 13, 19, 23, & 31 and what does this mean?

8. Some believe that the fossil beds containing billions of dead animals came from a prehistoric earth. What truth of scripture does this contradict from Genesis 1:31, Genesis 2:16-17, Genesis 3:22-24; Romans 5:12 and 1 Corinthians 15:21-22?
