Icebreaker: Share stories of how not paying attention can be dangerous and get you into trouble.

1. On what foundation are we to build our lives, and the Church?
Matthew 7:24-27; 1 Corinthians 3:9-13; 1 Peter 2:4-7

2. Whose words and instructions are recorded for us in the Bible?
Matthew 7:24; John 1:1-3; Hebrews 1:1-2

3. Talk about the danger of coming off anchor, of becoming disconnected from the instructions Jesus gave us to live by in the Bible and drifting off course on *the sea of life*. Hebrews 2:1

4. What does it mean *to give the more earnest heed to the things we have heard*? Hebrews 2:1 Proverbs 24:30-34

5. What part did the angels have in giving the Ten Commandments? Hebrews 2:2-3; Deuteronomy 33:2; Exodus 19:16-19; 20:19

6. What was the consequence when Israel disobeyed God's instructions and commandments at Sinai? Hebrews 2:2

7. What then is the inferred consequence of drifting away from Christ and neglecting to apply the salvation He has promised to us? Hebrews 2:3; 12:3-11; Psalm 89:27-34

8. How can believers neglect their salvation? Hebrews 2:3

9. How did God place His stamp of approval on His Son and on His Apostles – those who were responsible for writing the New Testament? Hebrews 2:3-4

10. What warning do we find in Hebrews 12:25-26 to Christians who drift away from obeying the Christ?

In what areas have I drifted away from complete obedience to Christ's instructions?

Are their areas of compromise in my life I need to confess to Christ?
