Text: Matthew 13:3-8, 18-23

Prayer

Icebreaker: Talk for a few minutes about the joy of farming/gardening and growing things. What is the aspiration of every farmer and gardener at planting time?

 What message did John the Baptist, Jesus, His disciples, and the Church share with unbelievers / those who are under Satan's dominion? Matthew 3:1-2; Mark 1:14-15; Luke 8:1; Matthew 10:7; Luke 24:47; Acts 20:21

2. What does it mean that *the Kingdom of Heaven* or *Kingdom of God* is at hand and is within you? Luke 17:20-21; John 18:36

3. What is God's method of propagation in Christ's Kingdom? Matthew 13:3; Luke 8:1; Mark 16:15; Acts 1:8; 8:4; Luke 24:47-48; Romans 10:12-17; Ecclesiastes 11:4-6; Psalm 126:6; Mark 4:26-29 4. What 4 types of soil does Jesus speak of in His parable? Matthew 13:4-8 5. What two things kept the seed from taking root on the wayside or pathway? v. 4 6. Why wasn't the seed on stony ground able to grow and produce a harvest? vs. 5-6 7. What was in the soil that prevented the seed from producing a harvest in verse 7? 8. Why would there be varying degrees of fruitfulness even in the good soil? v. 8 9. What does Satan and his cronies do with the truth that falls on hardened and confused hearts? verse 19

10. What kind of an individual is represented by the shallow rock obstructed soil? vs. 20-21

11. Is the person represented by the thorny ground a genuine believer? v. 22

12. How does Jesus define the thorns that choke the seed and keep it from producing a crop? vs. 22; Matthew 6:25-34; 1 Timothy 6:7-9

Think about it this week:

How can I cooperate with God in getting out the stones, cutting down the thorns and weeds that will make my life unfruitful?

What measures can I take to insure that my fruitfulness for God reaches its full potential, not just a 30 fold increase but 60, 80 or 100 fold?

We can get so busy making a living that we forget to make a life! How much of my life is going to add up to gold, silver and precious stones at the Judgment Seat of Christ, and leave a lasting impact on eternity? Tragically for many, their lives will only add up to wood, hay and straw, a puff of smoke and a pile of ashes.
