Galatians 6:7; Proverbs 26:2-3

4. What instructions did Jesus give His disciples in Mark 4:35, and what spiritual applications can we make from this verse.

5. What wonderful promise do we find in Isaiah 43:2-3 to help us through the storms of life?

6. What promise does Jesus make to us in Hebrews 13:5-6?

7. Do you think the terrible windstorm took Jesus by surprise, and is He surprised by the storms that come on us from out of the blue? Mark 4:37, John 16:30

8. What consolation and example should the disciples have taken from the fact that Jesus was asleep in their boat? Mark 4:38, Psalm 37:3-8, Philippians 4:6-7, John 14:27

9. How can God be glorified through the storms that you face in your life? Psalm 148:7-8

10. How would you answer the disciple's question in Mark 4:38,
Teacher, do You not care that we are perishing? 1 Peter 5:7 and Philippians 1:6

- Will you claim and apply God's promise in Isaiah 26:3?
