Prayer

Text: Luke 10:1-21

Icebreaker: Tell your small group about the joy of sharing your faith with another person. Have you had the privilege of leading someone to the Savior?

1. What purpose would Jesus have in sending 70 representatives into every city in Israel where He was about to go? Verse 1

2. What comparison did Jesus make when describing the mission of reaching the multitudes for Christ, and what prayer should we be praying for the great need of evangelizing the world around us? Verse 2; John 4:34-39; Matthew 9:37-38

3. How much do you have to know? How much Scripture do you have to memorize? How long should a person be a Christian before they begin sharing their Christian faith with others? Verses 3, 21; John 4:28-30; 9:24-25; Mark 5:18-20; Acts 9:3-5, 20-22

4. What do we learn from Jesus' instructions for their mission about the nature and purpose of their mission? Verses 4-8

5. What supernatural power did Jesus give the 70 to demonstrate they were His Kingdom representatives? Verse 9

6. How were they to demonstrate God's displeasure toward those who rejected them and their message? Verses 10-11

7. Discuss the greater accountability and judgment from God for those who have had more opportunity to hear the gospel compared to those who have not? Verses 12-16

8. What was the impact these 70 witnesses had on Satan's Kingdom and the demonic realm? Verses 17-19

9. What great event must we never get over, and what should cause us more joy than having power and victory over Satan and his demons? Verse 20

10. What impact did this successful mission have on Jesus? verse 21
