

Revelation 19:1-10  
TWO HALLELUJAHS

God is victorious over evil – Hallelujah #1 (1-5)

Who He is (1) (Exodus 34:6-7) – ***the loving, compassionate, and just God***

Belonging to God alone: Salvation – Power – Glory ***none can usurp Him***

Being true and just – in ALL His judgments (Revelation 16:5-7)

***You can receive His mercy or what you deserve***

What He has done (2) (Hebrews 12:25-27) – ***the culmination of His plan***

Condemned the great prostitute (II Peter 2:1-3) – ***false religious teaching***

Corruption and blood shed are avenged (Matthew 27:25) – ***they asked for it***

Worship expressed toward Him (3-5) – ***bowing before Him and praising Him***

For ever and ever evil is vanquished (I John 5:19) – ***Satan's authority is gone***

Four and twenty elders fall before Him (Revelation 4:10; 5:8,14; 11:18)

Fear His both small and great, His servants (Hebrews 13:15)

***May our lips confess His Name***

God is celebration the wedding of His Son – Hallelujah #2 (6-10)

Reigning over all – the time has come (John 14:1-3 + 7 years)

***The end of the wedding week – the celebration supper***

Rejoicing in Him – being glad

***He is fulfilling all that He promised for Israel and the Church***

Ready Bride – given the wedding garments (Matthew 25:10)

***Unless we have the oil, we will not receive the wedding garments***

Receiving an invitation – the wedding supper of the Lamb (John 3:28)

***John the Baptist is a guest at the wedding (not the bride)***

Reacting – overwhelmed with joy

***We should never worship God's servants (Luke 17:1/Hebrews 1:14)***

Worshipping the messenger (Matthew 4:9) – ***only fallen angels receive it***

Worshipping God – Savior's testimony (Revelation 4:9-10)

***All of prophecy points us to the One who is worthy of praise***

Discussion questions for Revelation 19:1-10

How is God's judgment shown toward us? (II Corinthians 5:21 / Romans 3:23-26)

***God placed all of our sin upon our Savior and He bore the wrath that we deserved. Jesus is the atoning sacrifice (propitiation) for our sins, He was punished in our place so that God remains just – sin was atoned for – and God is justified now in forgiving and receiving to Himself those who have put their faith in Jesus' work on the cross.***

What is He seeking from us in response? (I Peter 2:24 / Romans 1:5; 6:15-18 / John 4:24 / Titus 2:11-14) ***He wants us to die to sin, to give our lives to Him. He wants us to live by faith in obedience to Him. His expectation is that we will no longer make ourselves slaves to sin, but by His grace we will surrender our lives to His power and become slaves to righteousness. He wants true worshippers, those who are bowed in spirit to His Spirit and who live according to His truth (His Word). He is looking for those, who in response to Him, will allow the Spirit to work within them and thus live for His purpose and plan.***

What is necessary to become His Bride? (Matthew 22:11-14; 25:6-13)

***We must have wedding garments, having been made pure by the blood of the Lamb (Hebrews 10:14 / Revelation 12:11). We must also have our lamps + oil. Only the Holy Spirit can supply what is necessary for our regeneration and sanctification.***

How do we receive these? (Ephesians 1:13-14; 5:25-27/Revelation 3:4-5; 4:4; 7:13-14; 19:7)

***The Holy Spirit is given to us the moment we put our trust in Jesus and believe the message of the gospel. He is our seal and the deposit that guarantees our redemption. He is the One who keeps us and cleanses us, that we might be prepared when our Groom comes for us (I Thessalonians 4:13-18). Only those who have the Spirit will receive the wedding garments that represent the righteous acts of His saints – because it is by faith that we have received the righteousness that come from God (Romans 3:21-24)***
