- God intended men to become spiritual leaders
- The Apostles laid the <u>foundation</u> for the Church
- Men and women fulfill distinct roles
- God created Adam first

<u>Christ</u> – church <u>leaders</u> – <u>fathers</u> – <u>wives</u> – <u>children</u>

- Pastor, Elder and Bishop are used interchangeably in N.T.
 1 Timothy 3:2
- The home is the <u>testing</u> ground for church leadership
 1 Timothy 3:4-5; Titus 1:5-9
