F. He was teachable

III. Paul instructed 12 disciples of John the Baptist Acts 19:1-7

- A. They believed in the coming Messiah
- B. They had not heard of the Holy Spirit
- C. They were <u>baptized</u> into Jesus Christ
- D. They were <u>filled</u> with the Holy Spirit
 - 1. Tongues was a sign for unbelieving <u>Israel</u>
 Isaiah 28:11; 1 Corinthians 14:21
 - 2. How can I be filled with the Holy Spirit?
 Ephesians 5:18; Luke 11:13
 - a. I must be <u>saved</u>
 - b. I must walk in fellowship
