

✓ Paul charged them to <u>shepherd</u> God's flock vv 28-31

✓ Paul <u>commended</u> them to God and His Word v 32 Philippians 1:6; 2 Peter 1:3-4; Isaiah 55:10-11

✓ Paul reminded them to follow his <u>example</u> vv 33-35

✓ Paul <u>prayed</u> for them and said <u>goodbye</u> vv 36-38
