Two Types of Judgment

- I. Judgment that is wrong
 - 1. Judging <u>hypocritically</u> and self-righteously Matthew 7:1-6; Romans 2:1, 3, 21-22
 - 2. Judging in areas of <u>freedom</u> Romans 14:1-4, 10, 13
 - In essentials <u>unity</u>

In non-essentials - liberty

In all things - charity

- 3. Judging motives 1 Corinthians 4:5; Romans 2:16
- 4. Judging by outward <u>appearances</u> James 2:1-5; John 7:24

- II. Judgment that is <u>right</u> and necessary 2 Timothy 4:2 & 3
 - 1. When disagreements arise between <u>Christians</u>

1 Corinthians 6:1-5

2. When <u>leadership</u> is being chosen in the church

1 Timothy 3:2-12

- 3. When there exists serious <u>sin</u> in the church Matthew 18:15-17; I Corinthians 5:1-13 Titus 1:13, 2:15, 3:10
- When there exists false <u>teaching</u> and false <u>teachers</u> Matthew 7:15-20; I Corinthians 14:29; 1 John 4:1
