Romans 8:28-39

Six Important Questions

- 1) What shall we say to these things? v 31a
 - the depravity of all men

chapters 1:19 - 3:20

- showing us our need of the Savior
- justification by faith

chapters 3:31 - 5:21

sanctification by faith

chapters 6:1 - 8:30

- through the work of the Spirit
- orchestrating everything together for my good
- conforming me to Christ-likeness

The answer: PRAISE GOD!

2) If God is for me, who can stand against me? v 31b

> 1 John 4:4: Psalm 118:6: Luke 12:4-5; Hebrews 13:5-6

The answer: NO ONE!

3) Won't God give me everything I need? v 32

The answer: YES!

4) Would God bring charges against His child? v 33

The answer: OF COURSE NOT!

5) Would my Savior condemn me? v 34 Romans 4:25; Colossians 3:1-3; Hebrews 7:25; John 6:39-40

The answer: NO WAY!

6) What can <u>separate</u> me from the love of Christ? v 35-39

Matthew 5:11; 8:20; 1 Timothy 6:8; 1 Corinthians 4:11; 2 Corinthians 11:24-26; Acts 12:2; 2 Corinthians 4:8-11; Psalm 44:22

The answer: <u>ABSOLUTELY NOTHING!</u>

I am more than a conqueror through Christ v 37

> 2 Corinthians 2:14: Philippians 4:13; John 15:13

- Nothing can <u>separate</u> me from God's
 - Nothing in the realm of death or life
 - No physical or spiritual being
 - Nothing in the present or the <u>future</u>
 - Nothing in heaven above or earth beneath
 - No created being
