Unpardonable

Romans 9:15-18; Matthew 12:22-37

- God wants to save and forgive sinners
 - 2 Peter 3:9; Ezekiel 18:3-32;
 - Luke 19:10; John 3:16; 1 Timothy 1:15;
 - Hebrews 7:25; Isaiah 55:7

- A true believer cannot commit the unpardonable sin
 - John 5:24; 10:27-28; Philippians 1:6;
 - Psalm 89:27-33; Romans 8:1, 28, 38-39;

- Those outside of Christ are spiritually dead
 - John 3:7

- Born again means born from above - from the Holy Spirit
 - John 3:6; Titus 3:5-6

- The Holy Spirit draws the sinner to Christ
 - John 12:32; 16:8

- Without the Holy Spirit no one would
 - ♦ see their desperate condition before God
 - ♦ recognize the Savior
 - ♦ come to Jesus
 - John 6:44; Matthew 16:16-17; John 16:13-14

- The unpardonable sin is not a one-time offence

- It involves attributing the works of the Spirit to Satan
 - Matthew 9:32-34; John 7:20; 8:48, 52; 10:20

What is the unpardonable sin?

It is resisting until the Holy Spirit stops convicting

Acts 7:51; 5:38-39; 9:4-6; Genesis 6:3; 15:13-16

- I will never be any closer to salvation than today
 - Isaiah 55:6; 2 Corinthians 6:2; Hebrews 3:7-8

- It is dangerous to teeter in the doorway of decision
