The Significance of the C.R.O.S.S.

Jesus' <u>crucifixion</u> was prophesied centuries before

Revelation 13:8; Psalm 22:1-17; Isaiah 53:3-7; Mark 8:31-32; 9:31; 10:32-34; John 2:4; 7:6, 8, 30; 8:20; 12:23, 27; 13:1; 17:1

- Jesus' <u>repulsion</u> to the cross

  Matthew 26:29; 2 Corinthians 5:21;

  Revelation 14:10
- Jesus' obedience to do His Father's will

  John 4:34; 6:38; Isaiah 53:6

Jesus' sacrifice will cleanse from every sin Hebrews 9:26 Colossians 3:13-14

Jesus is willing to <u>save</u> me by His grace Ephesians 2:8-9; Acts 16:31

## The Cross Enforces Three Truths

1. Our sin must be extremely horrible

- 2. God's love is <u>wonderful</u> beyond comprehension
- 3. Salvation is a free gift
