Revelation 1:10

Why is Sunday called the Lord's Day?

1. It reminds us of the first day of creation

It is symbolic of a new <u>beginning</u>
2 Cor. 5:17

3. It commemorates Christ's resurrection

4. It celebrates the New <u>Covenant</u> Hebrews 8:13; Colossians 2:16-17; Galatians 4:10-11

5. The Jewish Festivals point us to Sunday

Leviticus 23:5, 10-11; 15-16; 1 Corinthians 5:7; 15:20; Psalm 118:22-24; Acts 2:1-4

The early church met on <u>Sunday</u>

Acts 20:7; 1 Corinthians 16:1-2
