The responsibilities of a priest

- ◆ To represent <u>God</u> to <u>man</u>
- ◆ To proclaim the word and will of God
- To represent man to God through his prayers
- ◆ To offer acceptable <u>sacrifices</u> to God

Problems with the Aaronic priesthood

- Aaron and his descendants were sinners
- Their sacrifices could not take <u>away</u> sin
- Their access to God's mercy seat was <u>limited</u>
- ◆ Their mortality
