Revelation 22 The beginning of the <u>eternal</u> <u>state</u> for the child of God

John 1:1 The Beginning of redemption

- A. The <u>Person</u> of Christ (vss. 1-5)
 - Logos = <u>God's thought expressed</u>
 - Revelation 22:13 Alpha and Omega
 - John declares Christ's <u>eternal existence</u> and place in the <u>Godhead</u>
 - God the Son was God the Father's

 <u>agent</u> in creating everything in the
 universe (vs. 3)
 - Zoe life, spiritual life is <u>IN Him</u> (vs. 4)
 - The darkness has not <u>overcome</u> the light (vs. 5)

- B. The <u>Proclaimer</u> of Christ (vss. 6-8)
 - John the Baptist came to <u>bear witness</u>
 to the Light (Jesus)
- C. The <u>Power</u> from Christ (vss. 9-14)
 - Christ Himself gives the authority to become a child of God by receiving Him
 (vs. 12)
 - When we are born from above, we are born of God, not by man's will (vs. 13)
 - The Word of God puts on flesh. This is the incarnation. God in the flesh!
 - The Word became flesh and tabernacled among us
 - The Son of God a perfect blend of grace and truth (vs. 14)

Man could not break out of his sin, so God broke into humanity to rescue him.
