We are free from the burden of our guilt, and we know His forgiveness. We can enjoy fellowship with Him. We can reflect is light to others, a light that grows brighter and brighter as we walk with Him.* 

What role do we play in lifting burdens and oppression? (I Timothy 2:1-2 / Galatians 6:2 / Proverbs 24:11-12 / Ezekiel 3:16-21 / Jude 22-23) *First, we need to pray for those who are in leadership positions. We are called to carry one another's burdens. We cannot ignore those who are being oppressed but must seek ways that God can use us to alleviate suffering. We need to warn and/or reach out to those who are headed the wrong way.*

Why is it not wise to align yourself with the powerbrokers of this world? They may enjoy comforts in this life but will be forever separated from God. He will destroy all those who come against Him.*
