Discussion questions for Isaiah 35

What changes would need to happen for God to bless and heal our land? (II Chronicles 7:14) We must first humble ourselves before God, that we may return to Him. We must cry out to Him in repentance. (Hosea 14:2) We must seek Him and turn from our wicked ways. It would require to gospel to be boldly shared and the hearts of the people ready to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. It would require God to be allowed back into our government institutions, our public schools, and our media and entertainment.

What can we offer that would bring healing to people in our land? We begin by sharing the gospel that they may have life. (Romans 1:16) We offer them His word, that they may grow and become equipped for His word. (II Timothy 3:16-17) We encourage them to be filled with His Spirit, offering themselves to Him. (Ephesians 5:18 / Romans 12:1-2) We lead them to walk in relationship with Jesus who loves them and will strengthen them. (II Peter 3:18 / Philippians 4:13)
