Loving as a Family

RESPECT (1-2)

Older men – as fathers (exhort and do not rebuke) (Exodus 20:12) Younger men – as brothers (Psalm 133:1) Older women – as mothers Younger women – as sisters (absolute purity) (Ephesians 5:3)

RESPONSIBILITY (3-8)

Family

Caring for the elderly (not just financial) (Leviticus 19:32) Children & grandchildren included (I Thessalonians 2:7, 11-12) Conforming to the faith Not caring for family is to deny the faith (Psalm 27:3; 78:3-7) Not caring for family is worse than being an unbeliever (I Cor. 5:1)

Widows

Put their hope in God (Dt. 10:18 / Psalm 68:5 / James 1:27) Pray continually (I Thess. 5:17) Pursuing pleasure would mean they were already dead (II Timothy 3:4)

REPUTATION (9-15)

Older widows - to be put on the widows list

Over 60

One man woman

Outwardly known for good deeds (I Timothy 2:10)

Having raised children

Hospitable (I Peter 4:9)

Humbly washing the feet of the saints

Helping those in trouble

Heart devoted to doing good

Younger widows

Marry – to not give in to sensual temptation and break your vow (I Cor. 7:9) Make babies – to not become idle

Manage your own home – to not become a gossip or a busybody (Titus 2:4-5)
