Light & darkness (Genesis 1:4) – *He separates them (Eph. 5:8-11)* Prosperity & disaster (Isaiah 26:3-4, 14-17) – *He offers both peace and discipline* Righteousness & salvation (Philippian 3:9 / Hebrews 2:2)

He alone is the source of both

Those who question God (9-13)

Woe to those:

Who quarrel with their Maker (Psalm 2:1-6) – *Do we know better than Him?*Who questions what He makes (Jeremiah 18:5-6 / Psalm 139:13-14)
Who give orders concerning His works – *We are made by and for Him (Eph 2:10)*Will of God prevails – *it is wise to align ourselves with His will*Cyrus will follow God's path (Acts 26:14) – *don't kick against the goads*Cyrus will rebuild God's Temple (II Chronicles 36:23)

Those who trust in what is seen (14-17) - why trust in the temporal? (II Cor. 4:18)

They will see: - every eye will see (Matthew 24:27, 30)

That God is with His people (Zechariah 2:8-9; 12:2-3) – **the apple of His eye** That there is no other God (II Kings 19:17-19 / Zechariah 12:10) – **call on Him** The unseen God is real (I Peter 1:8-9) – **filling those who love Him with inexpressible joy** He shames the makers of idols (Jonah 2:8) – **they forfeit His grace (Gal. 5:4)** He saves His own with an everlasting salvation (John 6:39-40)
