Announced to ends of the earth (Acts 1:8) <i>Our commission (Matthew 28:19)</i>

The sought after city (Isaiah 2:3) <i>People longing for truth and justice</i>	

Called the Holy people: the Redeemed of the LORD (Isaiah 35:10; 37:31-32) Called the 'City No Longer Deserted' (Ezekiel 36:12) How are we made righteous? (Include what it means to be given a new name and what it means to be noticed by our Lord) (Romans 3:19-22 / Philippians 3:7-11 / John 1:12-13 / Ephesians 3:14-15 / I John 3:1 / Revelation 2:17; 3:12 / Ezekiel 34:12 / Psalm 103:13-14; 136:23) *Our righteousness comes only through faith in Jesus – no one is declared righteous by observing the law. Our own righteousness is a hindrance to obtaining the true righteousness from God. When we believe in Christ, we become children of God. We belong to Him and take on the family name (the Name of the Father). When we see Him, we will be given a new name. Our place in the Holy City will be how we are known, having His name upon us. He is our Great Shepherd and He watches over His sheep. He knows and understands our weakness and has compassion upon us. His love endures forever.*

How are we praised? (Include what it means to be protected, to be producing fruit, and to walk the pathway of hope) (Zephaniah 3:17-19 / Romans 2:29 / I Corinthians 4:5 / II Corinthians 9:13 / I Peter 1:7 / Psalm 3:3; 27:1-3 / Hebrews 13:5-6 / Matthew 13:22-23 / John 15:5-8 / Titus 2:11-14 / II Timothy 4:6-8) The Mighty God will rejoice over His people with singing! Praise from God is for those who are truly His, those whose hearts have been made new. When all things are brought into the light, God will praise those whose deeds and motives were for glorifying Him. (in other words, the things He did through us) When we are obedient to the Lord and are generous in our care for others it leads them to praise God for what they see in us. When our faith is tested and is proved genuine, it results in praise, glory, and honor at His coming. God is our shield, He is the lifter of our heads. God is our stronghold, no matter how dark the circumstances, He is our strength and light. God is our helper, we do not need to fear man because He is always with us. Those who take His word to heart and put it into practice will bear fruit for Him. We must abide in Him and in His word to see this happen. Our hope is in the blessed appearing of our Savior who has redeemed us and to whom we belong. As His chosen people, we are eager to follow Him and live in a manner that is pleasing to Him. May our faith stand firm, may we run the race marked out for us, and may we long for His appearing.
