Matthew 6:9-13 / Luke 11:1-4 “The Lord’s Prayer”

Mark 1:35 “Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where He prayed.”

Luke 11:1 “One day Jesus was praying in a certain place. When He finished, one of His disciples said to Him, ‘Lord, teach us to pray, just as John taught the disciples.’”

Matthew 21:22 “If you believe, you will receive whatever you ask for in prayer.”

James 1:6 “But when he asks, he must believe and not doubt, because he who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind.”

John 15:7 “If you remain in Me and My words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be given you.”

John 16:23 “In that day you will no longer ask Me anything. I tell you the truth, My Father will give you whatever you ask in My name.”

Psalms 66:18 “If I had cherished sin in my heart, the Lord would not have listened”

I John 3:21-22 “Dear friends, if our hearts do not condemn us, we have confidence before God and receive from Him anything we ask, because we obey His commands and do what pleases Him.”

James 4:3 “When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, that you may spend what you get on your pleasures.”

I John 5:14-15 “This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us – whatever we ask – we know that we have what we asked of Him.”

James 4:2 “You want something but don’t get it. You kill and covet, but you cannot have what you want. You quarrel and fight. You do not have, because you do not ask God.”

II Chronicles 16:12 “In the thirty-ninth year of his reign Asa was afflicted with a disease in his feet. Though his disease was severe, even in his illness he did not seek help from the LORD, but only from the physicians.”

Proverbs 3:5-6 “Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight.”

Romans 12:1 “Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God’s mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God – this is your spiritual act of worship.”

I John 1:9 “If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.”

Luke 7:30 “But the Pharisees and experts in the law rejected God’s purpose for themselves, because they had not been baptized by John.”

Psalms 57:2 “I cry out to God Most High, to God, who fulfills His purpose for me.”

Matthew 5:16 “In the same way, let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven.”

I Peter 3:15 “But in your hearts set apart Christ Jesus as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect”

Psalms 119:18 “Open my eyes that I may see wonderful things in your law.”
